

Reading Strategies

A **strategy** is a reading skill you have learned. The skill becomes a strategy when you understand the skill and use it when you are reading something new.

Examples of reading skills:

- visualizing (picture in your head)
- predicting (guessing what will happen)
- retelling (tell what happened 1, 2, 3,...)
- identifying confusing parts
- context clues (figuring out meaning)
- summarizing (tell what story was about)
- self-correct (does that make sense?)
- cause/effect (understanding why something happens)
