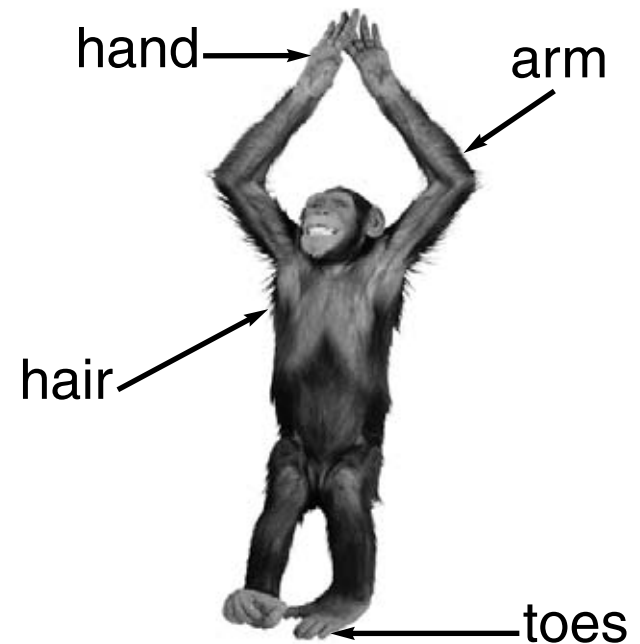

Apes are related to you and me.

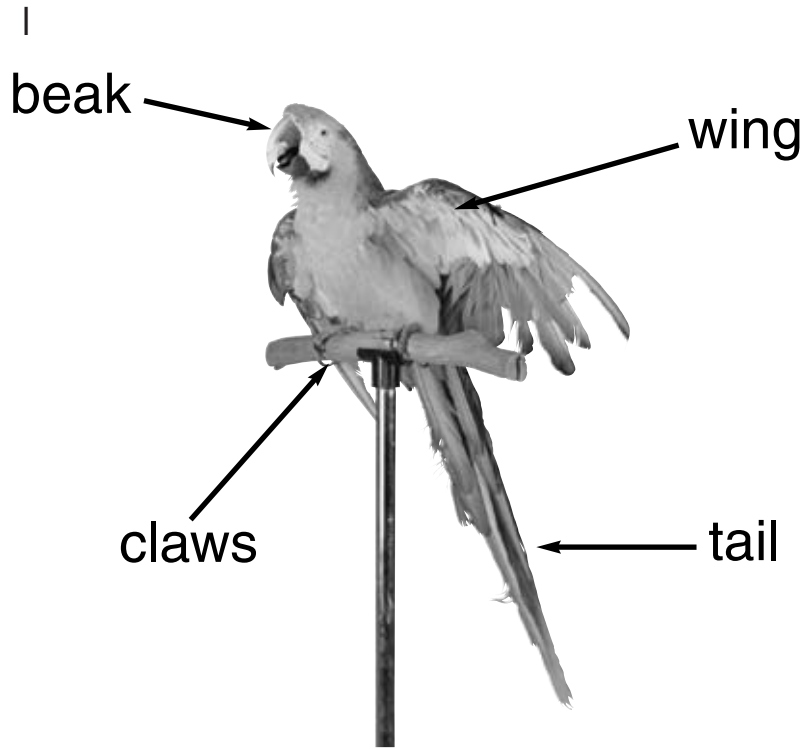

## Parrot

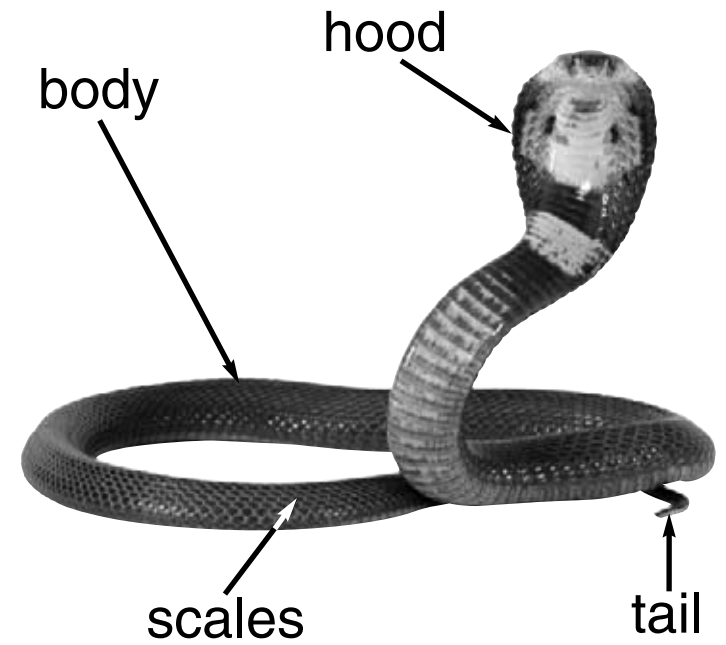
A parrot is a pretty bird.

Some parrots can talk.



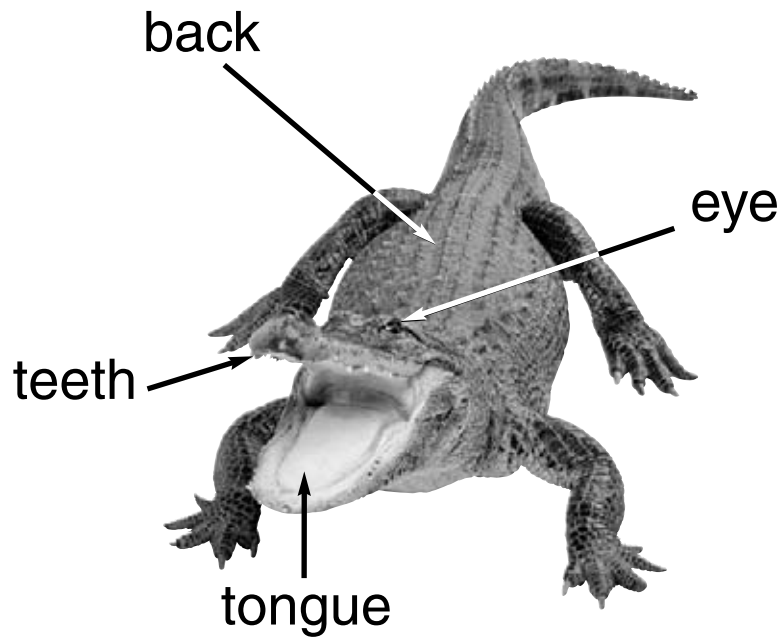
## Cobra

A cobra spreads the hood around its neck and hisses.



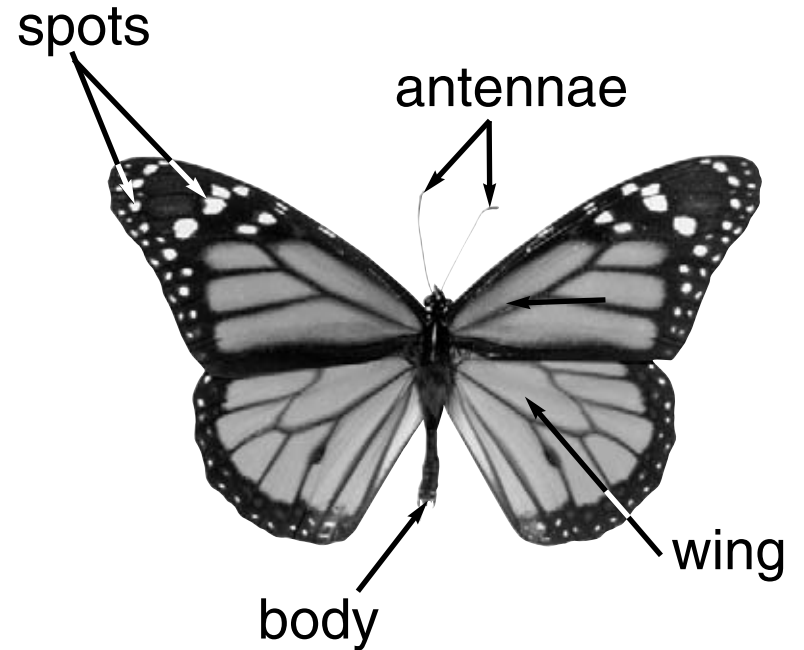
## Alligator

## Butterfly

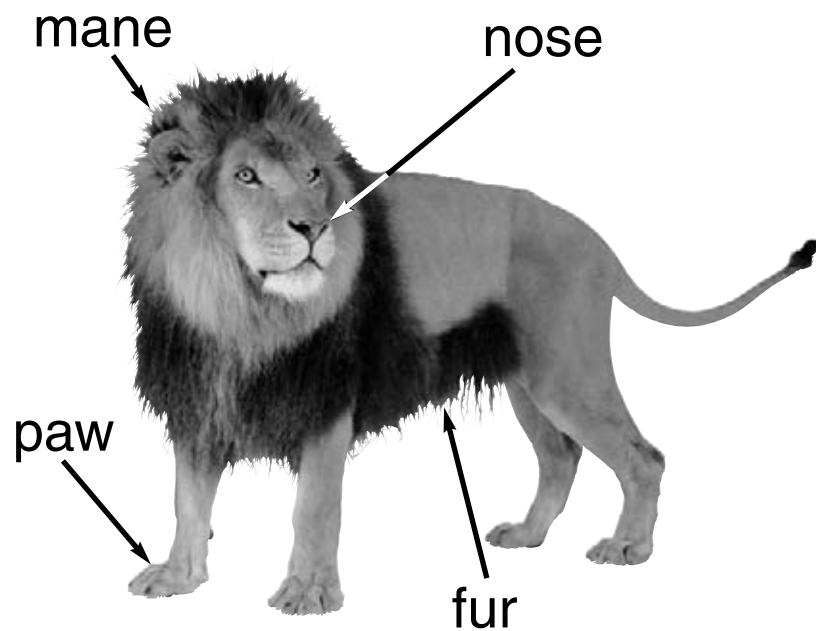
A butterfly is a flying insect.

## Lion

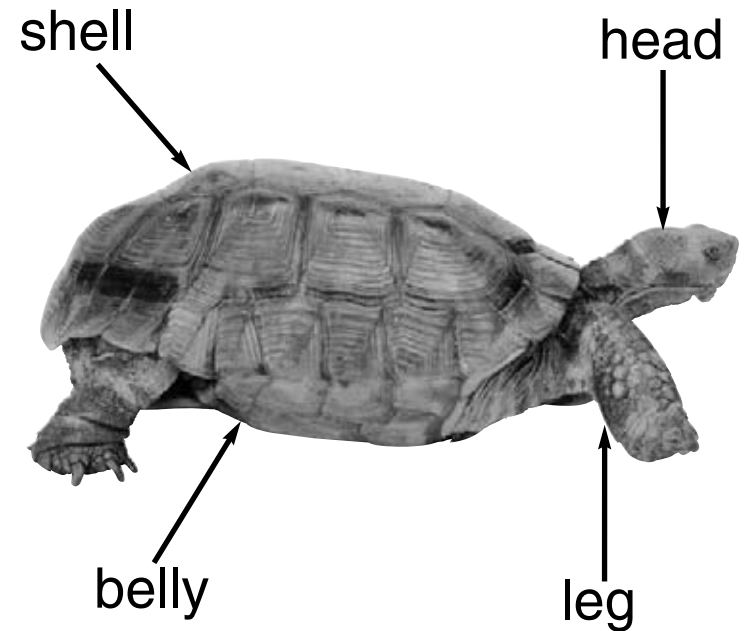
A lion is a big cat.

Male lions have big manes.



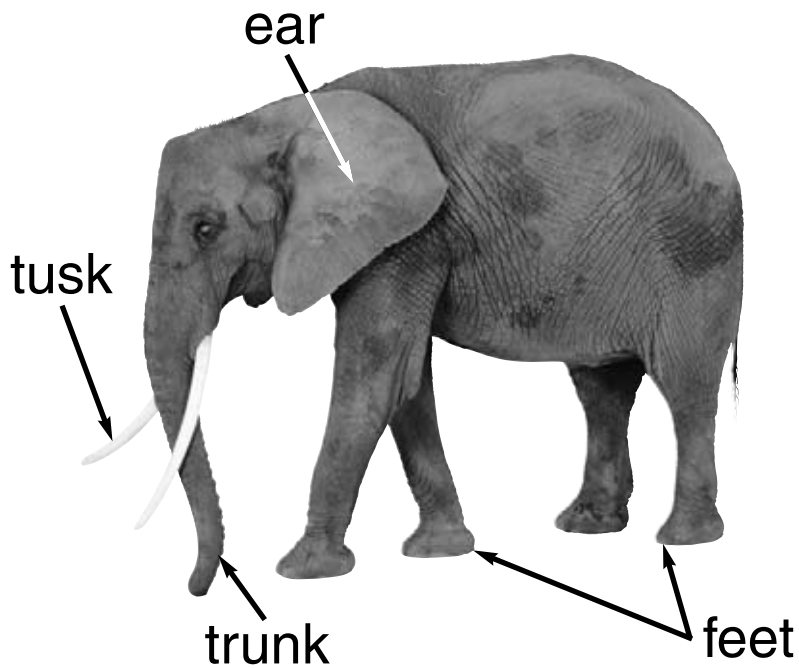
## Tortoise
