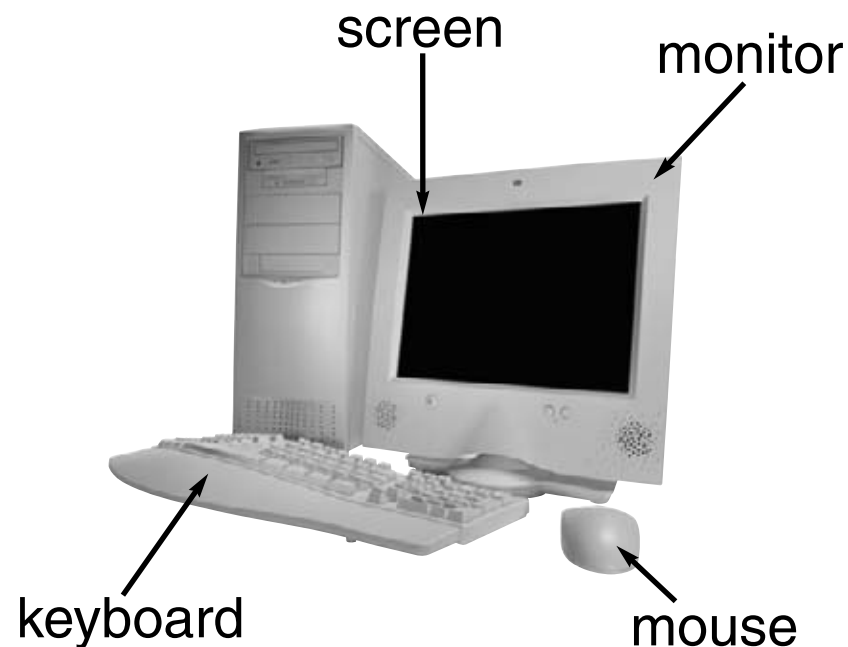

I like to use our computer.

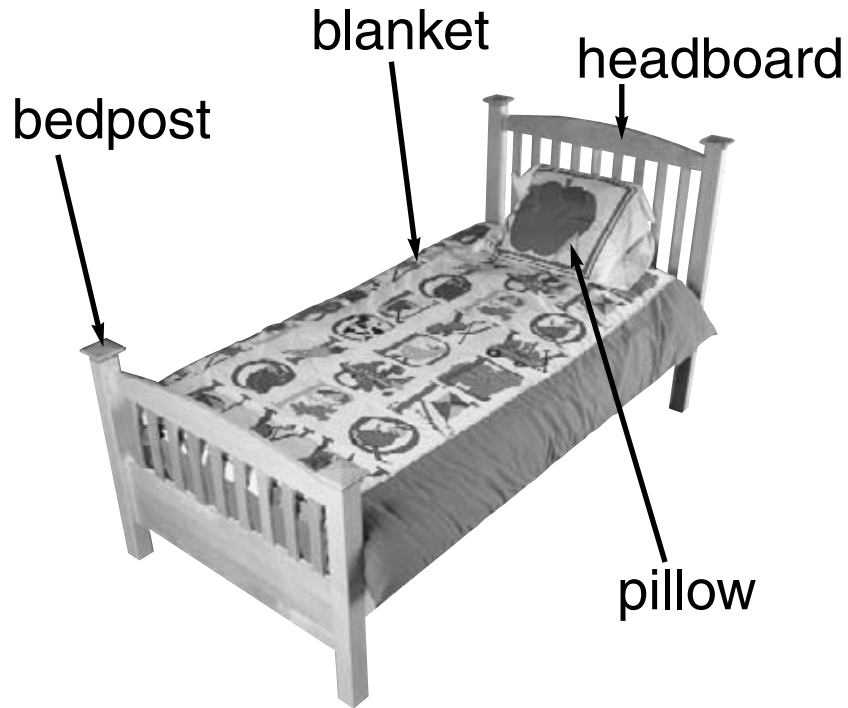

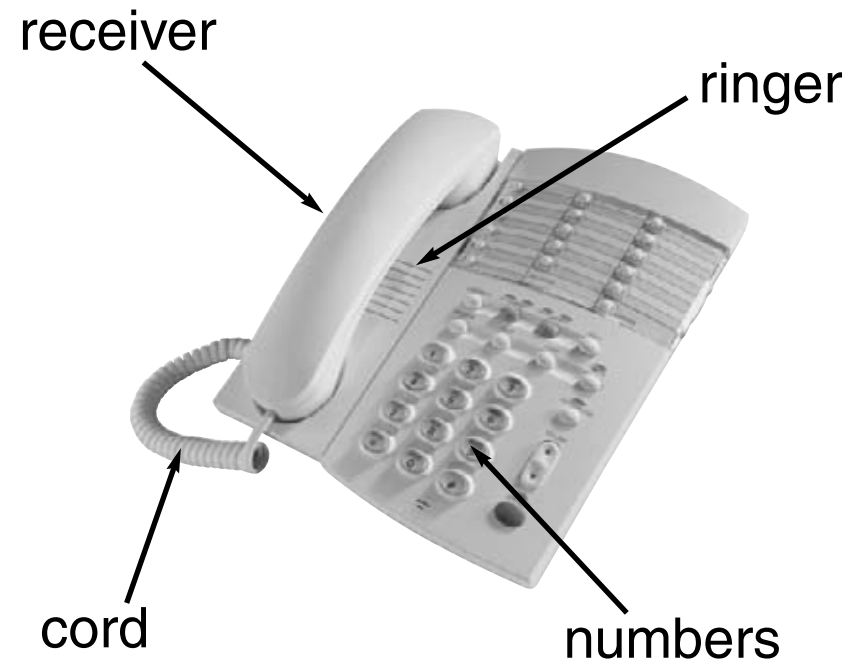


## Bed

my pillow and four bedposts.



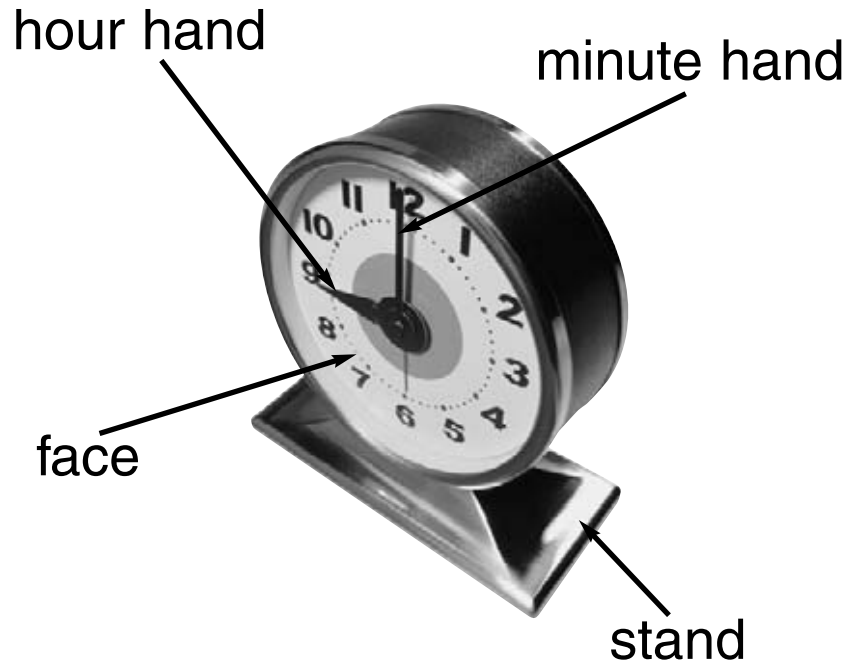
## Telephone

I dial the numbers to make a call.

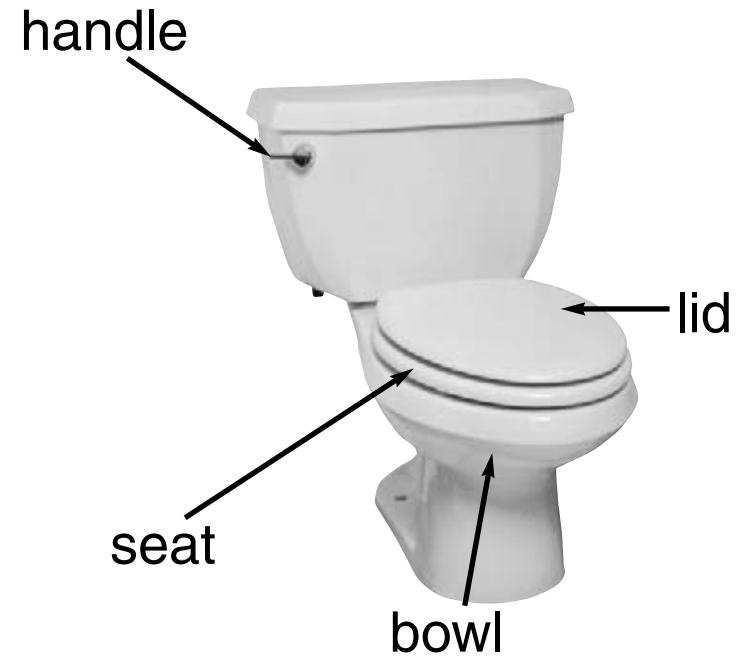


## Clock

The long, skinny minute hand points to the minutes.

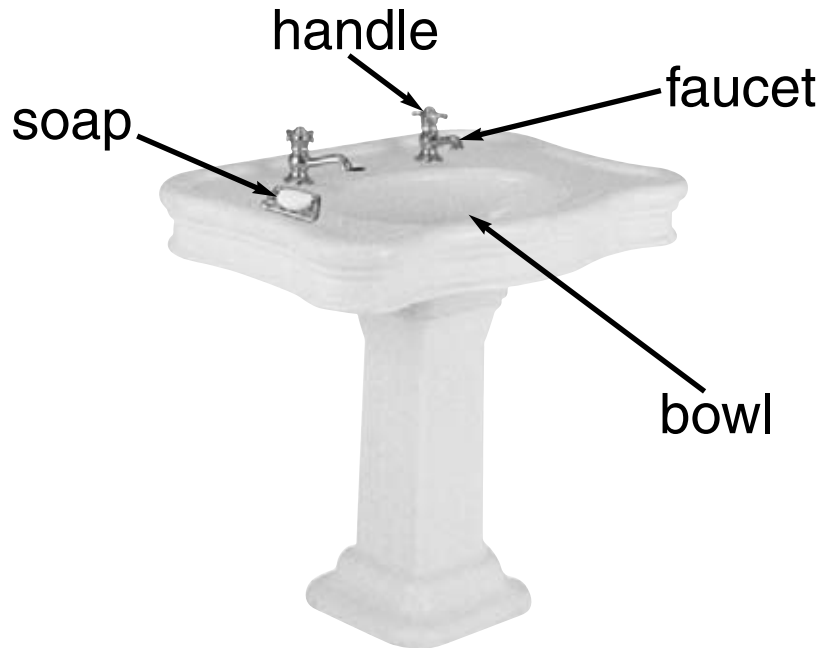


## Toilet

I lift the lid of the toilet and sit on the seat.

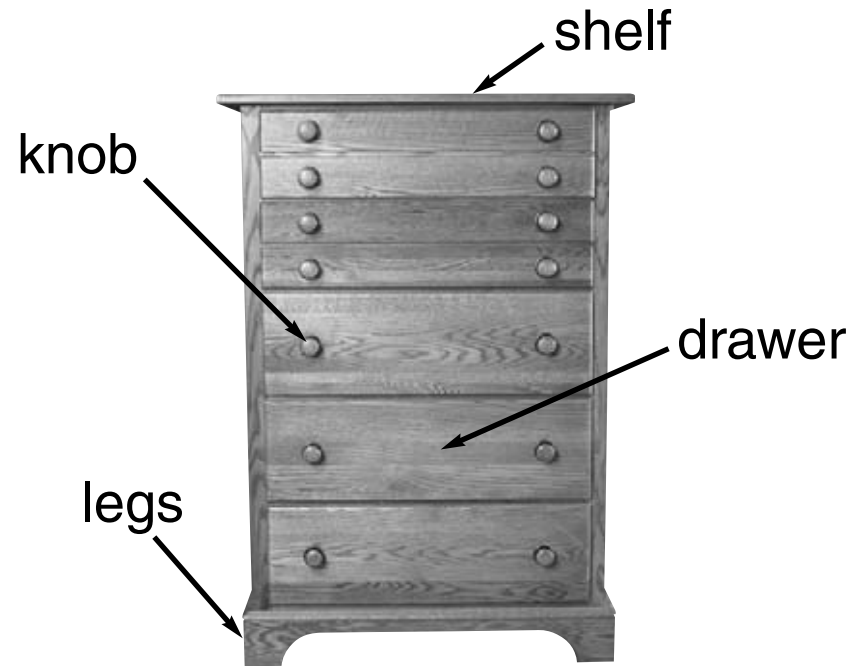
When I am finished, I push the handle to flush the toilet.

 on the top of the sink.



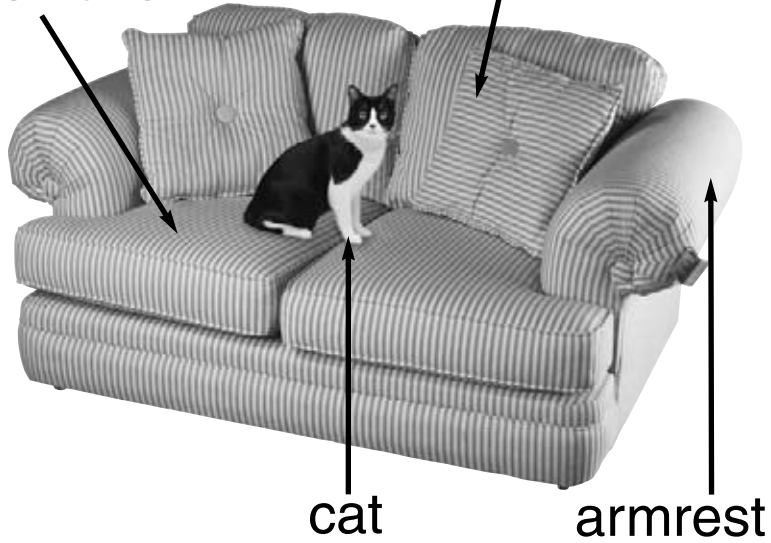
## Dresser
