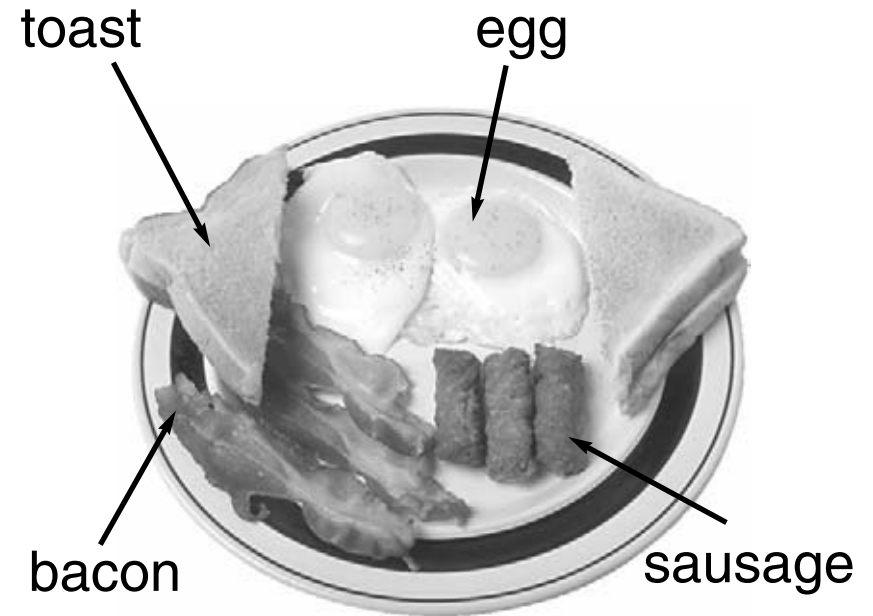

My plate is full.

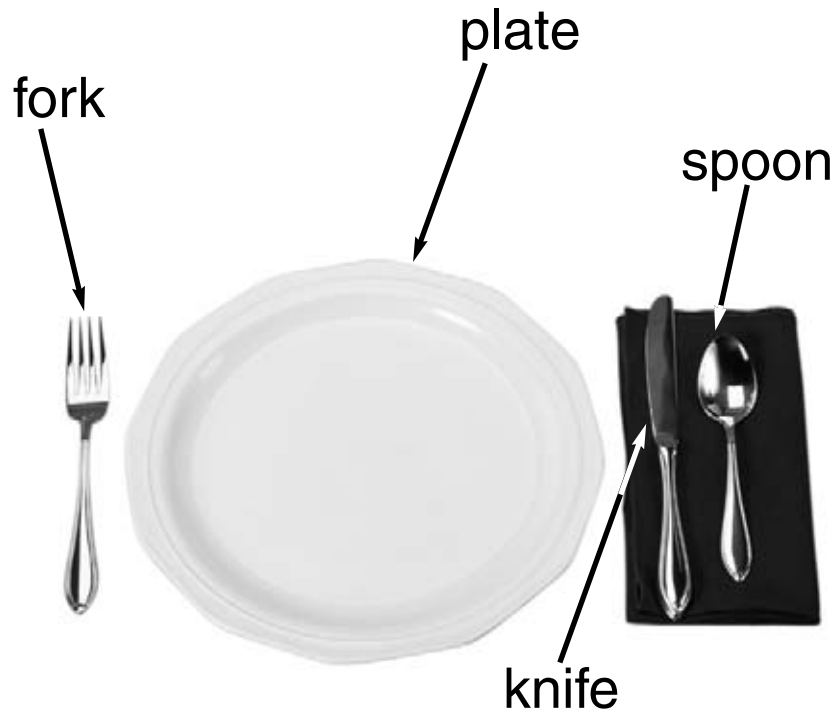

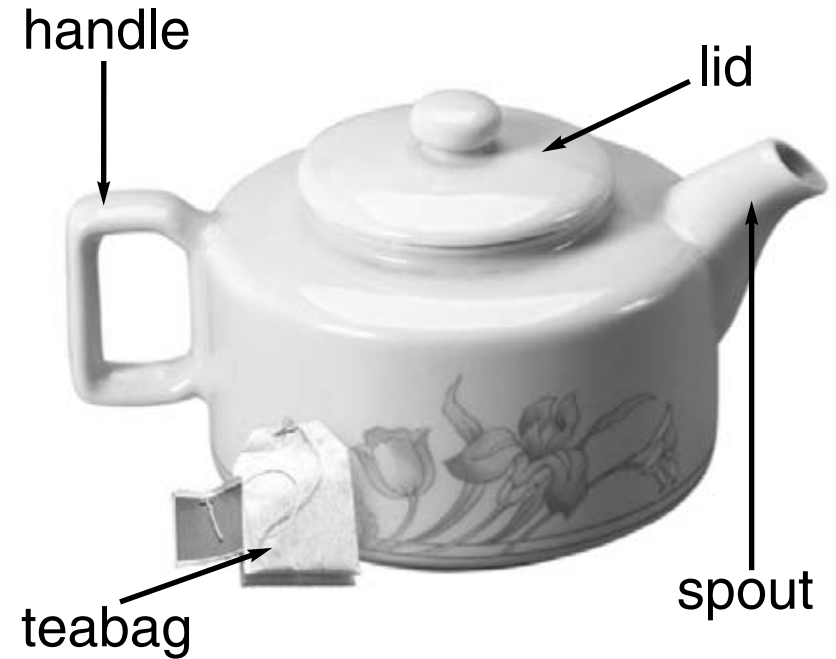
Place Setting

I have a little teapot.

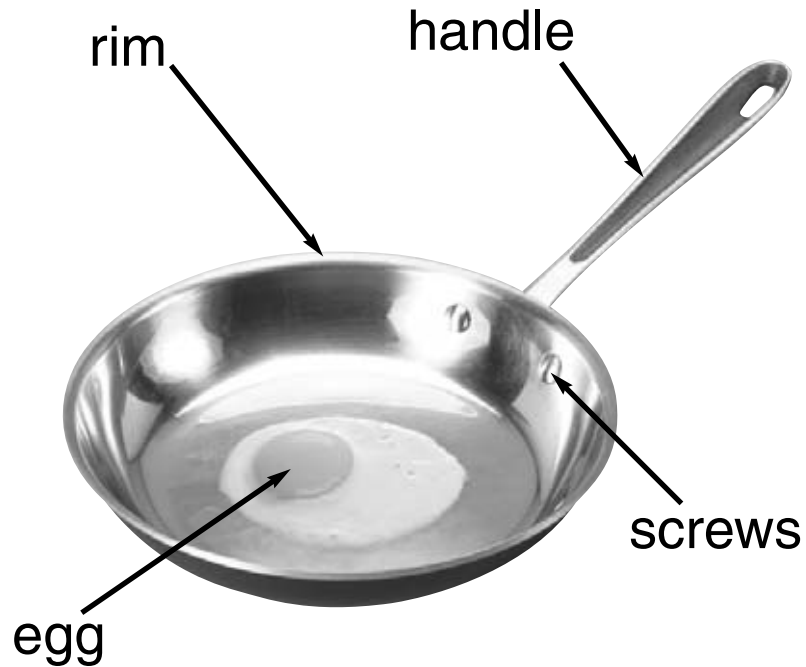
It has a handle on the side.

into my cup.

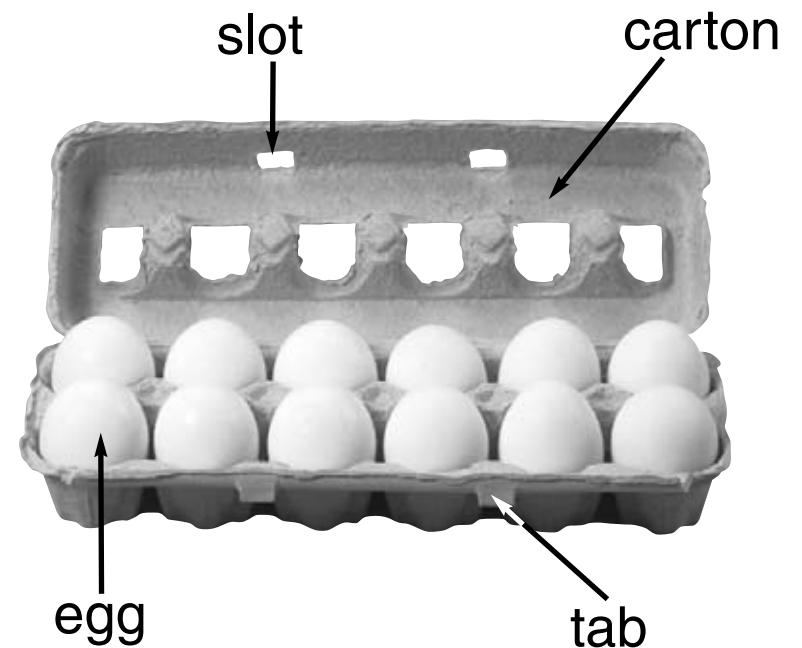

Frying Pan

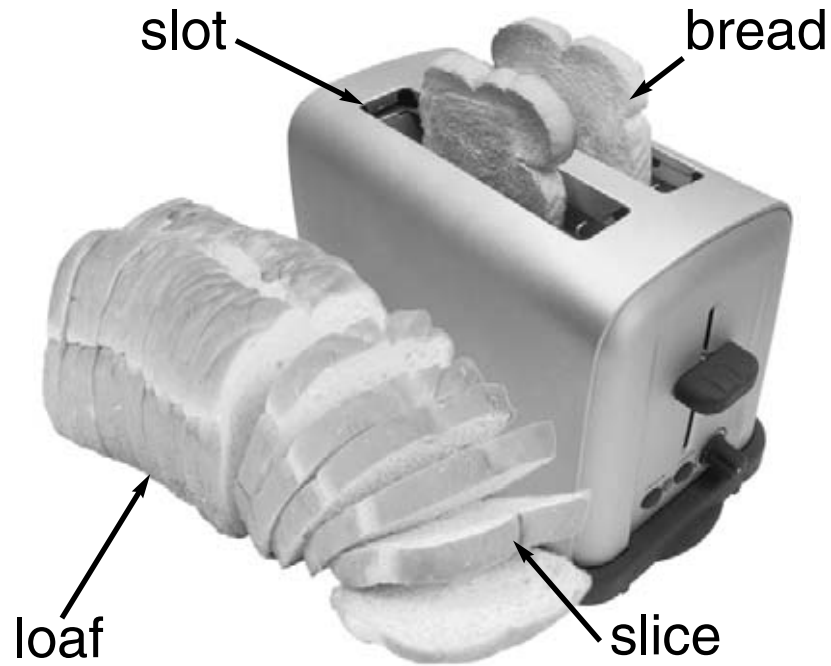
The frying pan sits on the stove.

Egg Carton

 the carton closed.



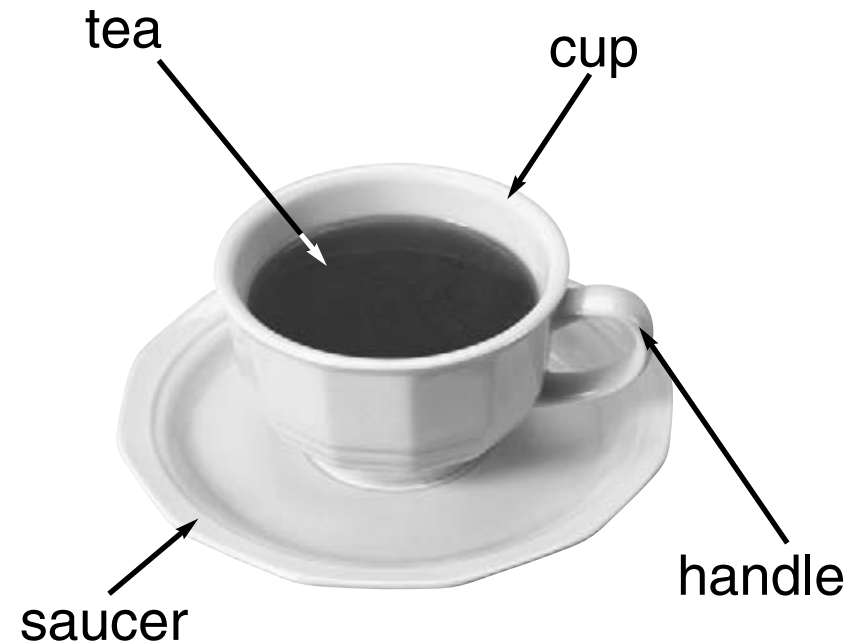
Toaster

The bread pops up when it is done!



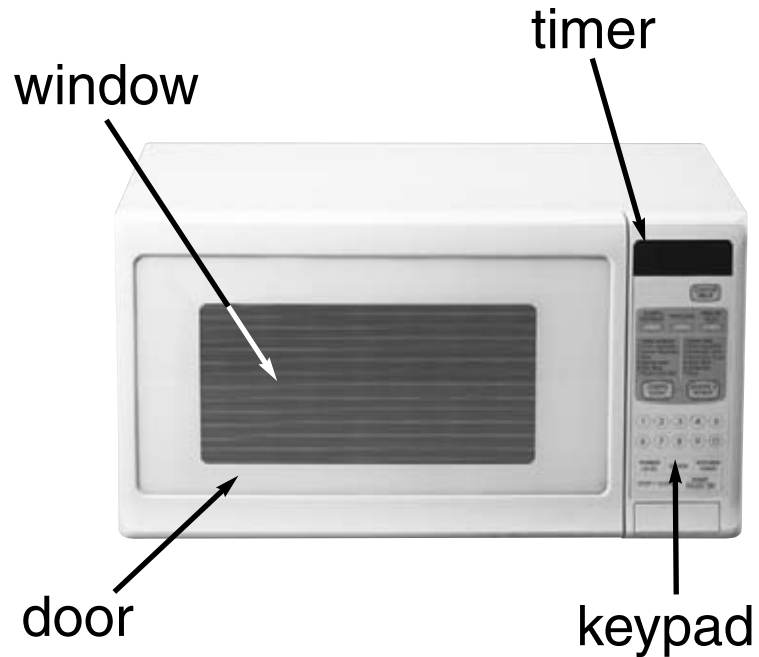
Teacup and Saucer
