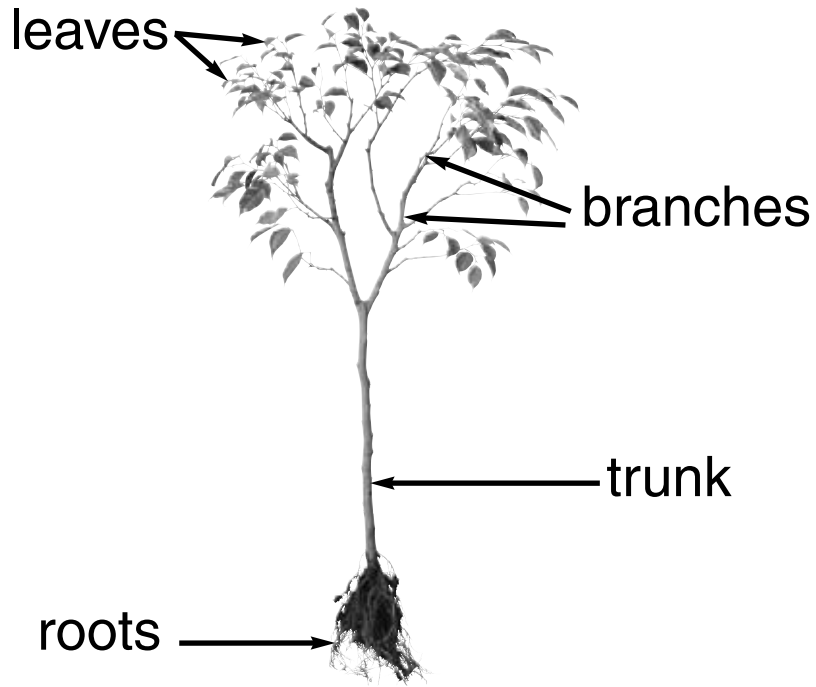

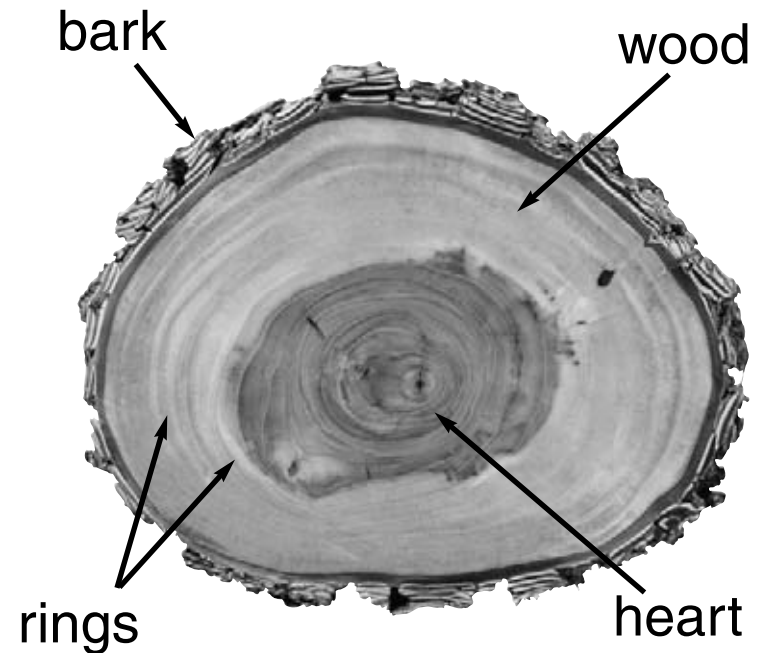

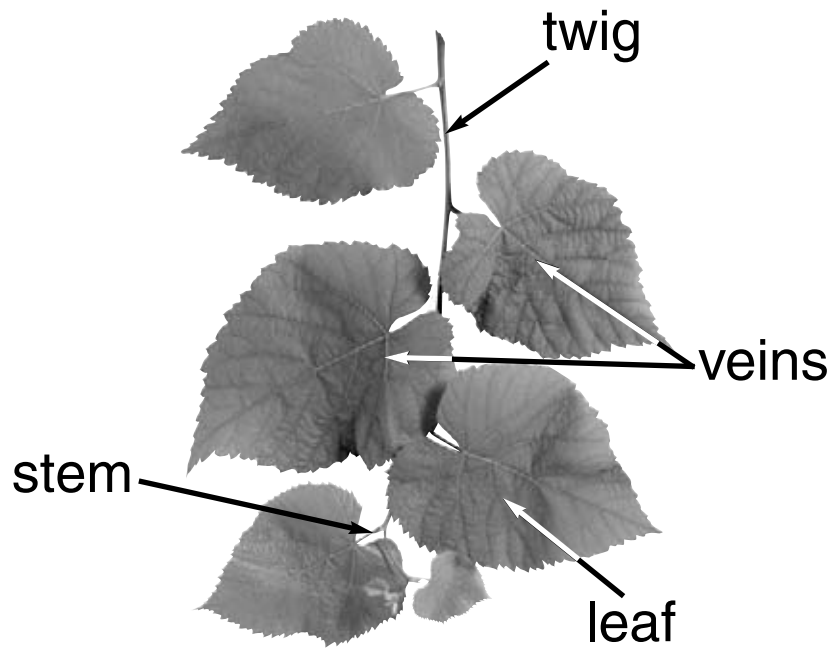
## Tree

## Leaves

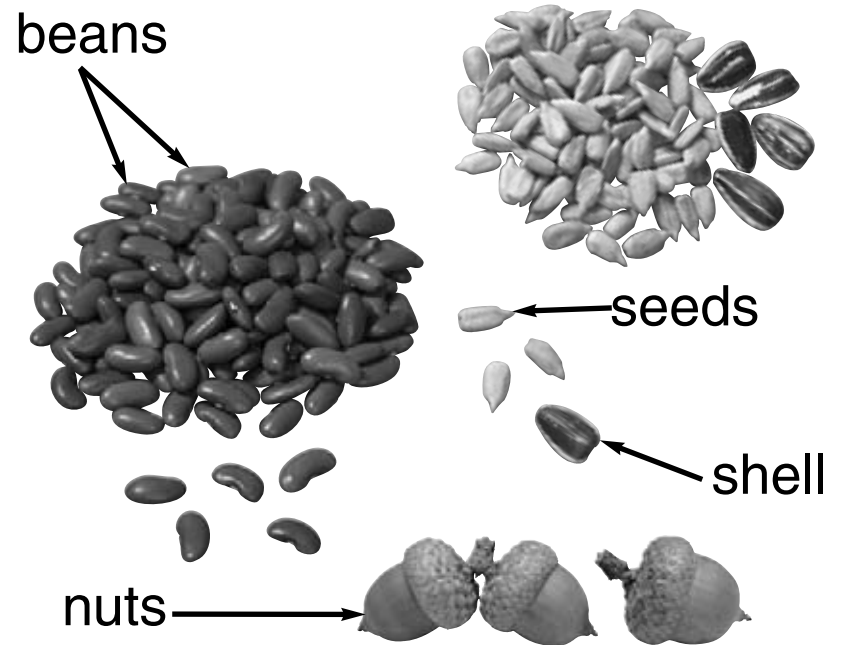
A twig grows from a plant's branch.

Acorns are nuts.

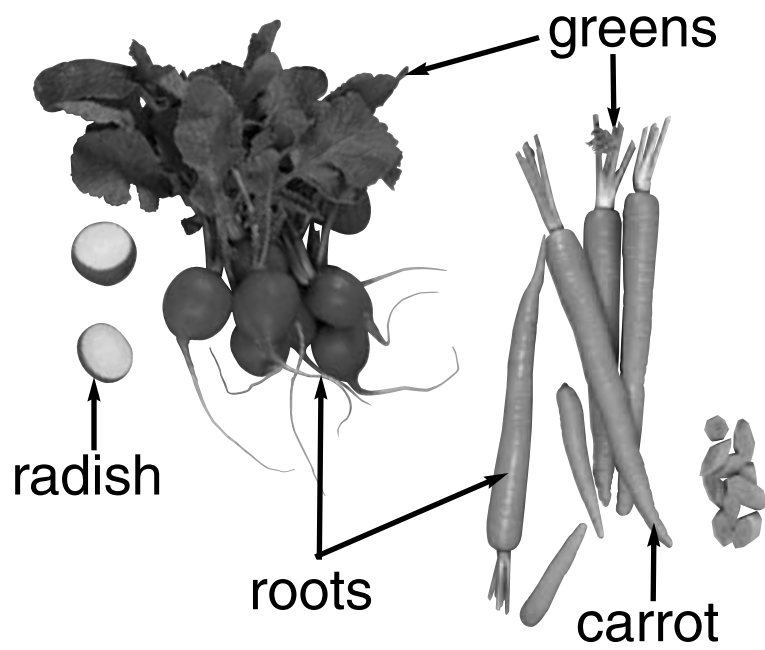
Kidney beans are beans.

Sunflower seeds have hard shells.

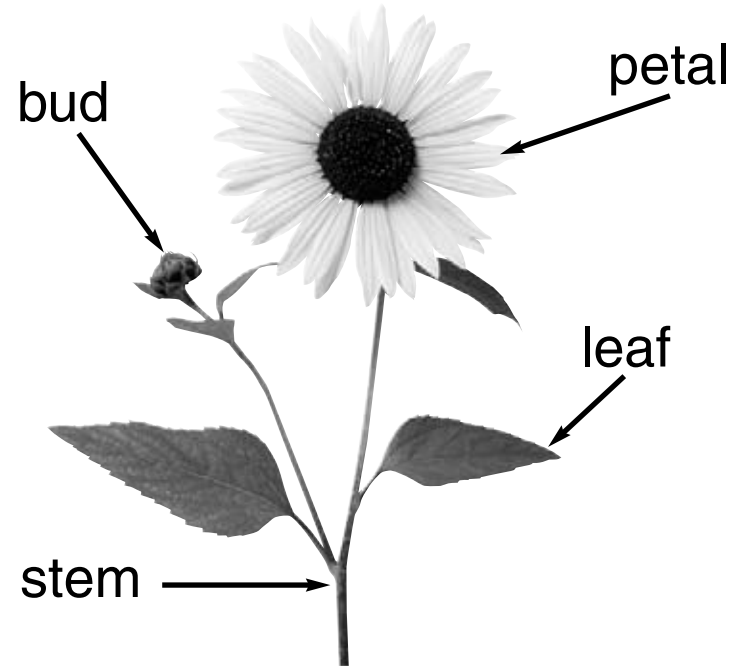
Nuts and beans are seeds, too.

New plants grow from seeds.



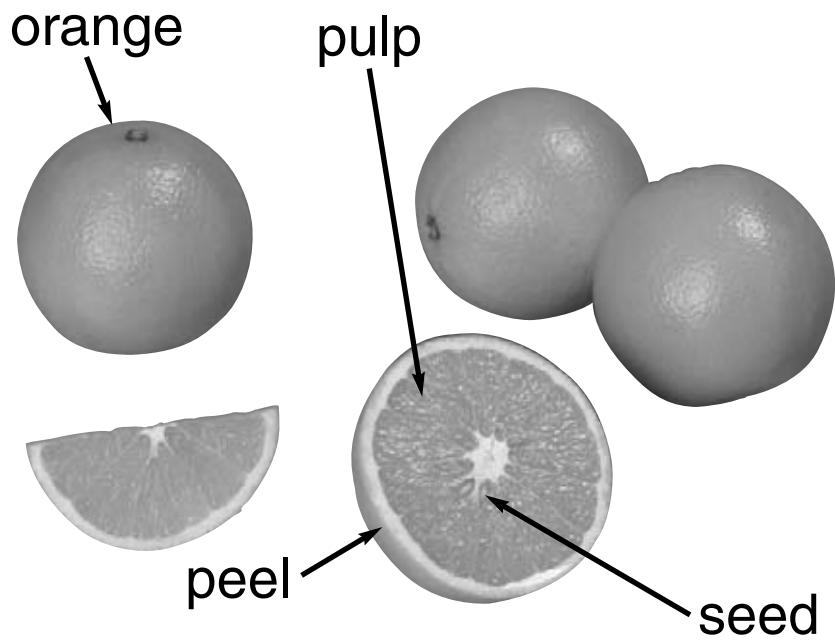
## Roots

 to catch the sunlight.



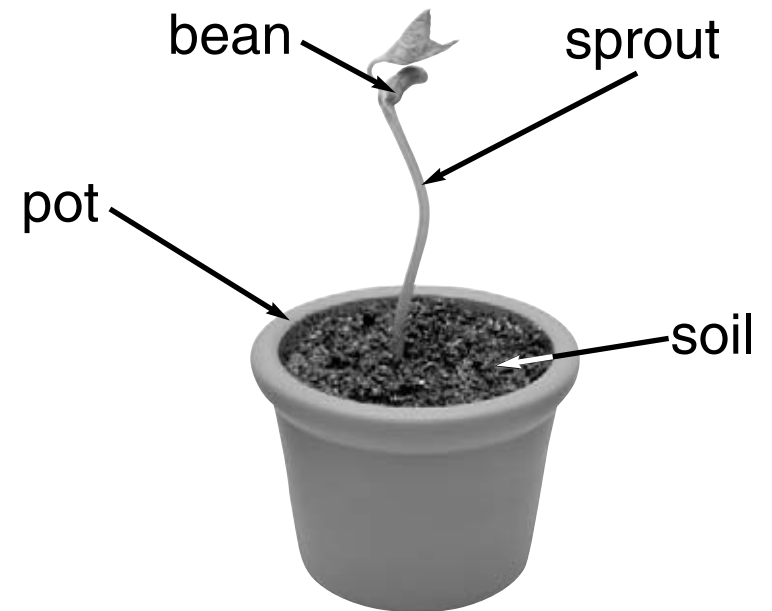
## Fruits
